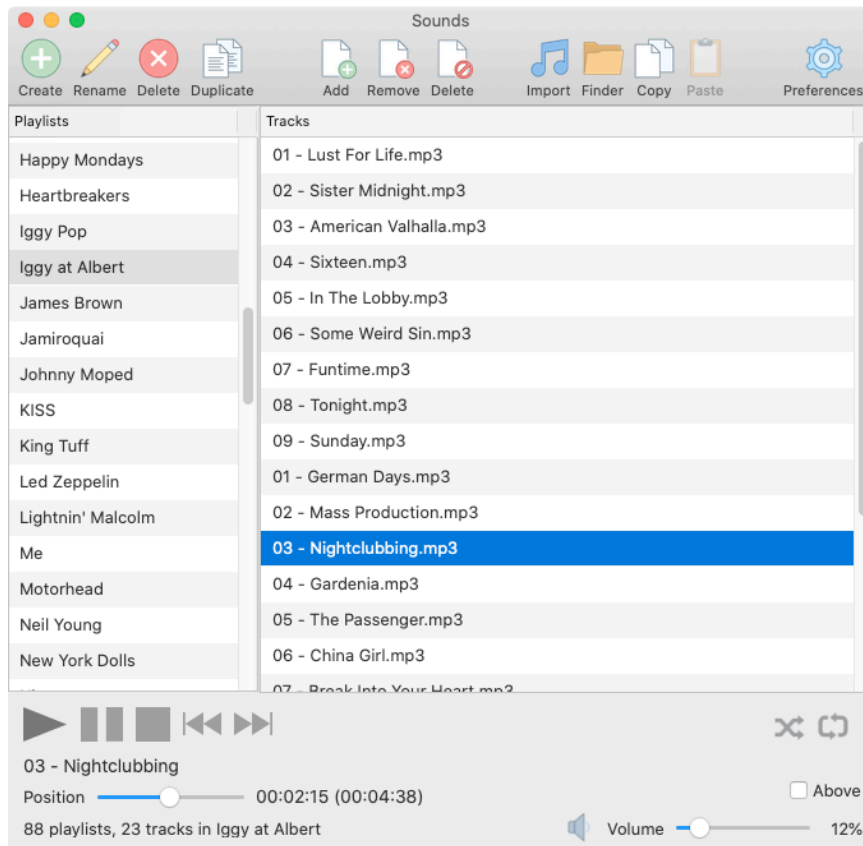


Sounds

Introduction



Sounds is a simple, easy to use music player. You can quickly locate and add music to play lists by drag dropping from Finder (or Explorer) or importing from iTunes (Mac only).

Features

Creating a playlist

Click "Create" on the toolbar and enter a name for your playlist in the window which appears. Playlists can be backed up and restored using the options in Preferences.

Alternatively, you can drag/drop a folder full of music files to the playlist area, or drag/drop music files to the tracklist area.

Renaming a playlist

Select "Rename" from the toolbar and enter a name for the playlist.

Deleting a playlist

Select the playlists you want to delete in the list and click "Delete" from the toolbar.

Adding tracks

You can drag/drop music files from Finder onto the tracklist area, or click "Add" from the toolbar.

You can move tracks up and down the tracklist window by selecting them and dragging them with the mouse, allowing re-ordering.

You can add other tracks from other playlists you have created using the Copy and Paste buttons on the toolbar. To move tracks (rather than copy) hold down the Alt/Option key when clicking the Copy button.

Import from iTunes/Music

Choose "Import" from the toolbar. Select the desired playlists and click "Import selected playlist(s)".

Removing tracks

Select the tracks you want to remove in the tracklist, then click "Remove" from the toolbar. The actual files are NOT deleted. To delete the actual

files, see below:

Removing files

Select the tracks you want to remove in the tracklist, then click "Delete" from the toolbar (page icon with crossed red circle). The tracks will be removed from the list and the actual files deleted (sent to Trash).

Playing tracks

Use the controls at the bottom left of the main window to start, stop, pause and go to next or previous tracks. You can also double-click on a track to start playing it.

The following keys also control playback:

ENTER - play

SPACE BAR - pause

ESCAPE - stop

RIGHT ARROW - next track

LEFT ARROW - previous track

The total time of the track is shown, along with the elapsed time.

You can repeat a track by checking the repeat icon (lower right).

To shuffle the tracklist click the shuffle icon (bottom right, first icon).

To mute the currently playing song click the Volume icon next to the volume slider control. Click again for sound.

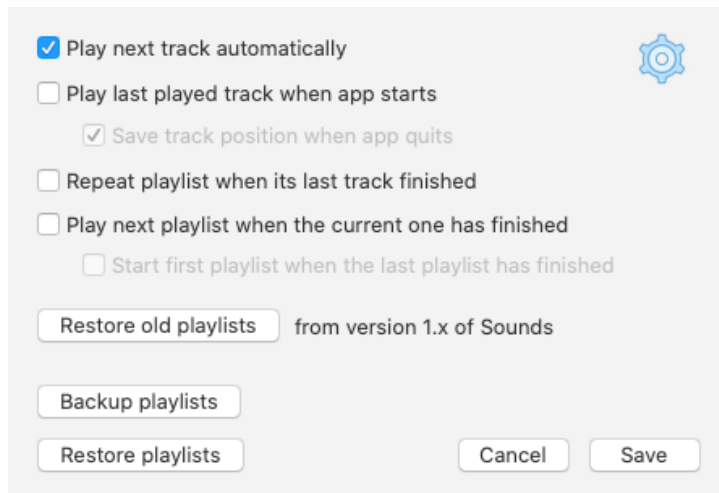
When a track is playing, clicking its name to highlight the track in the track list.

Double-clicking a playlist will start playing the tracks within it.

Enlarging the font

Press Command+B to toggle the font for the playlist and tracklist between small and large.

Preferences



Play next track automatically

Does as it says.

Play last track when app starts

Resumes playing the track which was last played before you quit the app.

Save track position when app quits

The position within the track you were playing the last time you used the application will be resumed when you next use the application.

Repeat playlist when last track has finished

The playlist will start again from the first track.

Play next playlist when current one has finished

Does exactly as it says.

Start first playlist when last playlist has finished

Available when the above option is 'on', this option will start playing the first playlist when the last one has ended.

Backup playlists

Click the button to backup the current playlists to a folder.

Restore playlists

Restore backed up playlists to the app.

Restore old playlists

If you have playlists from a version 1.x of Sounds you can locate them using this feature and import them into Sounds 2.x
